Dear Parent/Carer

We hope that you and your families are well at this time.

This year, Transition Day takes place on **Wednesday 1st July 2026**. We look forward to greeting all new pupils on site for the first time.

The day is a great opportunity for your son/daughter to meet their new form tutor, to meet some of their new subject teachers, become more familiar with the school site and to make new friends before starting at Cardinal Newman in September.

Your son/daughter should arrive in school at **8.50am** and **enter through the main front gates OR via the Cinder Path pedestrian gate. The Tamworth Road gate will not be open**. On arrival, they will be met by members of staff and will be directed to their signing in location before meeting their tutor in the Pope Francis Hall. **Please note that parents should not come onto site at the beginning of the day.**

All students should attend in their primary school uniform. Lunch will be provided for all pupils but pupils are welcome to bring in their own packed lunch. The day will finish at **2.20pm**, when students can be collected or they can wait until 3.10pm to travel home with older siblings.

Please note that parents/carers are responsible for arranging transport to and from the day. Due to the parking restrictions and traffic congestion, vehicles are NOT allowed on site for collection of pupils at the end of the day.
